MR. BELLUCCI: The reason for the
urgency is, there's been a tremendous amount of complaints coming in, and we wanted to accommodate not only the town but our good Deputy Chief of Staff who's been fielding a lot of these calls. So that's the main reason we asked for the courtesy to put it on tonight's agenda.

ACTING COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR NEALS:Well, Michael, there is also the issue of the damage to the property.

MR. BELLUCCI: And to be able to do the work for the engineering, they're going to try to prevent the Abba building from being hit, and they're going to do some engineering work, and the resolution allows us to do that faster as well.

FREEHOLDER GANZ: Are you prepared to do this for every applicant that is in need of comparable resolution?

CHAIRMAN SULLIVAN: I can answer that, Mike.

The answer is no. I was contacted by the administration. There seemed to be a public safety issue that really warranted to do it right away. It's not something that we're going to make commonplace, it happens once in a blue moon, and I approved it.

FREEHOLDER GANZ: If there's a public safety issue, no argument.

CHAIRMAN SULLIVAN: Thank you.

MR. BELLUCCI: Thank you, Chairman.
